A Registration Summary will be emailed from our office following this deadline. If there are any issues with your registration including misspelled names or contest errors, please contact us immediately.


All contestants, delegates, and candidates must be submitted members of SkillsUSA by March 1. There are no exceptions.



4. Register Attendee Screen

-Choose a member from the drop down (NOTE: if the name does not appear in the drop down, the person may not be a member. All registered students and advisors must be members by March 1)

-Select contest(s). A student may participate in one “Skilled and Technical Sciences Contest” and one “Leadership Development Contest” (with the exception of TeamWorks and Photo students).

-Many contests, including leadership, are limited per chapter, which is the school, not per program or advisor. Please plan preliminary contests accordingly.

Team Contests

Students competing on a team contest must be sequenced. All members of a team must have the same code. Each member gets a sequence number. For instance a team of 3 in Welding Fabrication would be team A1, A2, and A3. It is critical if you have multiple teams in a contest to sequence them correctly for scoring purposes.
