Contest	Video Production
Skill Performance	The contest assesses skills through the development, design and delivery of a short video ranging in time between 15 seconds and 120 seconds. Typically, this will be a promo, commercial, PSA or recap type video. Each team shall be comprised of two student members. Each team will write, plan, produce and complete a short video and then present it to the judges for questions, clarifications and feedback.

Resume	Resume must be submitted in typed and printed format to judges when entering presentation on Saturday.

Supplied by Tech Committee	Facility space – green screen w/lights, tables, chairs, meeting rooms, common areas and outdoor spaces for filming, NO Audio/Video Production Equipment is Supplied
Supplied by Contestant	a. 1-2 Laptop/desktop computers per team with production software (video, graphics and sound) b. Any video production equipment needed including but not limited to: cameras, tripods, microphones, lights, monopods, shoulder rigs, etc.
Other	Please bring a power strip and extension cord for computer used to write script. No WIFI is provided so please DO NOT plan on using google docs for script writing or any online sources for sound files. Copyrighted material in particular music CANNOT be used in the submission and students are required to credit their music sources. ALL Advisors are required to remain in the lobby area during contest time and are not permitted to assist with story development or production of the video. If students require technical assistance it needs to be done in the lobby under supervision of others.
