

WORLD SKILLS POLICY



The following policy applies to the international conference World Skills and the national SkillsUSA student selection process.

Every two years WorldSkills hosts the world championships of skills which attracts more than 1,300 Competitors from more than 70 countries. There are competitions in over fifty skills across a wide range of industries — from joinery to floristry; hairdressing to electronics; and autobody repair to bakery.

Student member and/or school is responsible for all items if they are selected to participate in a trial for World Skills. SkillsUSA Arizona will not purchase items, reimburse items, or provide funds for any part of the trial process.

If a student member is selected to be a part of the SkillsUSA WorldSkills team, based on a successful trial, SkillsUSA Arizona will purchase or reimburse the following items:

- Cost of student Registration + Hotel Accommodation at the conference hotel or up to the total cost of the conference hotel
- Cost of student Airfare

SkillsUSA Arizona will not purchase, reimburse, or provide funds for the following items:

- Transportation to and from the airport
- Meals or meal per diem
- Any Baggage fees
- Any Shipping fees
- Any contest supply or equipment
