Contest	Action Skills
Skill Performance	The demonstration is a presentation of an occupational skill accompanied by a clear explanation of the topic through the use of examples, experiments, displays or practical operations.
Team/Ind	Individual
Limits	<b>IEP Required</b> , All contestants must provide a verification letter from the school's principal to <a href="mailto:info@azskillsusa.org">info@azskillsusa.org</a> By March 1.
Date/Location/Start Time	April 13; PCC; Appointment Times Begin at 8 AM
Attire	Contest requires business attire (T-Shirts and Jeans are NOT acceptable and may be penalized) Contestants may not wear any attire that shows school name
Resume	Copy of resume on-site required.

Supplied by Tech Committee	a. Time keeper b. All necessary information and furnishings for judges and technical committee
Supplied by Contestant	a. All materials and equipment needed for the demonstration to be completed two times, once for the preliminaries and again for the finals, if required b. The contestant will present a 3"x5" card with the following three items: 1. The contestant's number 2. The topic or purpose of the demonstration 3. The contestant's training program
Other	Any skill may be demonstrated if it is related to the occupational program of the contestant. The demonstration shall be at least five minutes in length, but shall not exceed seven minutes.
