Contest	Community Service
Skill Performance	The contest will consist of two parts: a notebook outlining the chapter community service project and a live presentation by the chapter team. The chapter will organize the year's community service activities and present its best community service project to a panel of judges. Only one project may be presented. Notebooks containing information about more than one project will not be judged. The notebook and presentation should represent a community service project that was conceived, planned and completed during the current school year.
