Preparation and submission of a portfolio, completed at home. 3. Complete an application at contest time — 30 minutes will be allowed <p><i>Note:</i> A card (3"x5" or 4"x6") with necessary information may be used to assist in completing the application.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 4. Participate in an in-depth interview with the interviewers (judges),
