PARKING

Parking is on your own. The Jefferson Street Garage has offered our group a \$5 parking rate. The 4th Street entrance can accommodate oversized vehicles.

We also suggest utilizing the METRO Light Rail by dropping participants off at the PCC and sending your vehicle to park in a free Park-and-Ride lot. The closest lots are 38th Street/Washington Street or Central Avenue/Camelback Road. The fee to ride the Light Rail is \$3.50 for an all day pass. The passenger stop for the PCC is 3rd Street/Washington (Westbound) or 3rd Street /Jefferson (Eastbound).

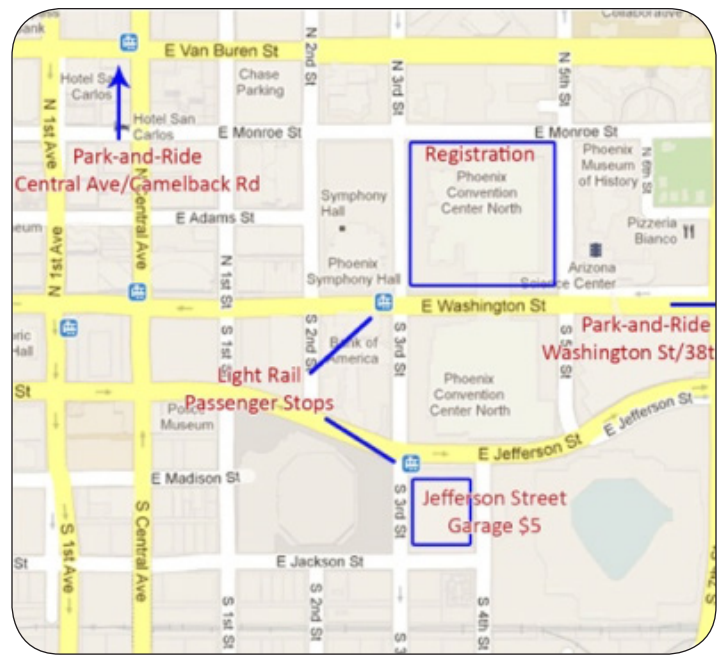
The entrance to the registration area is E Monroe Street between N 3rd Street and N 5th Street.
