Process for Completion

1. PRE- WORK: Research the SkillsUSA Framework and write your 'Framework Story'.
 - a. Go to: <https://www.skillsusa.org/about/skillsusa-framework/>
 - b. Write a minimum 300-word essay of your 'Framework Story'
 - c. What is a 'Framework Story'? Think of how the SkillsUSA Framework has already impacted you for your future career. Or how you use the essential elements in your daily life.
 - d. This essay must be printed and submitted at the time of the statesman submission deadline at LTC.
2. Recite the answers to the statesman application questions to current state officers. Beginning Thursday at 3PM, all members who have their National Statesman may sign. Each person may sign-off up to 3 items. Most answers can be found in your LTC Workbook.
3. Attend and actively participate in all LTC sessions.
4. Give your completed statesman materials with your 'Framework Story' to your chapter team leader. He or she will bring those materials to the Iron Horse lobby by **Thursday at 7:00PM**.

Advanced Statesman Applicants: All advanced statesman applicants must complete both the statesman and advanced statesman application. Members who have completed the statesman from a prior year are eligible to complete the advanced statesman. If a member has not completed the statesman from a prior year, they will not be eligible to complete the advanced statesman.
