

SkillsUSA Arizona Leadership and Skills Conference Contest Info Sheet

The following are important contest points and Arizona updates. All contest rules may not be listed.

Contest	T-Shirt Design
Skill Performance	The contest consists of two parts: 1. Evaluation of the T-shirt design 2. Oral presentation and questions and answers session. All contestants will be asked the same questions determined by the judges before the start of the contest.
Team/Ind	Individual
Limits	Designs due to SkillsUSA Arizona office by February 15 Limit of 10 designs per program.
Date/Location/Start Time	April 13th; PCC; Appointment Times Begin at 8 AM Only top 10 invited to interview at conference
Attire	Contest requires SkillsUSA Official Dress or business attire (T-Shirts and Jeans are NOT acceptable and may be penalized) Contestants may not wear any attire that shows school name
Resume	Copy of resume on-site required.

Supplied by Tech Committee	a. Time keeper and judges b. All necessary information for the judges and technical committee c. Data projector
Supplied by Contestant	a. 2 Renderings of design in accordance with technical standard. One rendering must be submitted to SkillsUSA Arizona by February 15 for preliminary selection. Second rendering to be used for interview at conference. Design may not change from preliminary selection to final interview. b. Supporting materials for the interview portion of the contest
Other	Designs must be submitted in accordance with requirements as outlined by the technical standard. Designs may use no more than 3 colors. Submissions must include a no more than 300 word paragraph outlining why he/she feels other students would want to wear the shirt. All time requirements must be followed per technical standard. Winning design will represent Arizona at the 2020 NLSC.
